



## Tahitian Noni® Place B&B: A Beaver Valley Gem

Nestled in the rolling hills of the Beaver Valley, Ontario, Tahitian Noni® Place B&B, is a charming rural retreat, near the town of Flesherton. This delightful Victorian-style establishment is well situated for all-seasons fun and relaxation. Open since 1998, when the house was constructed, it is surrounded by fifty acres of property. Trails for hiking, cross-country skiing, or snow shoeing have been cleared so visitors can experience the peace and beauty of nature at their leisure.

Owner, Bob Shearer, offers year round accommodations which combine Victorian charm with modern convenience. The Loft, a favourite with guests, has a fireplace, fridge and microwave. The West Wing is a large room also with a fireplace while the Honeymoon Suite is equipped with a jacuzzi tub ensuite. Each room has a private bath, TV, VCR, and DVD and can accommodate up to four people. Distinctive décor also sets each room apart

The Wilderness Cabin is a rather unique accommodation. Built originally as a maple sugar shack, Bob had the idea to offer it as an alternative experience. "It's really one step above camping," Bob says of the cabin which uses collected rain water for washing/showering and provides that rural staple, the outhouse. Set in a clearing in the bush, about 2000 feet from the main house, the cabin is secluded and holds four people. It is certainly an appeal to the pioneering spirit!

Breakfast, cooked on an old-fashioned wood stove, is served in the Solarium Dining Room, overlooking the pond, or outside on the extensive deck when weather permits. Guests are welcome to sit by the wood-burning fireplace in the cozy living room and to enjoy big screen TV. Rates range from T\$90-T\$135, double occupancy, but weekday and seasonal rates are available on request.

Tahitian Noni® Place B & B can deliver even more relaxation in the Hot Stone Massage and Reflexology Room. These services are available on request and require an appointment in advance. In addition, the property also boasts a hot tub. What a great way to ease stress or tired muscles in a peaceful country setting!

Although this B&B allows a grand opportunity to relax, it is also ideally located for many activities. In winter, down hill skiers can access Talisman Mountain Resort and Beaver Valley Ski Club, both only ten minutes away. A half-hour drive takes the visitor to Collingwood and the slopes of Blue Mountain Ski Resort. Summer draws people to the lake: the shores of Georgian Bay are only a short drive from the B&B. The small towns along the bay bustle and the marinas and beaches are full of activity in the high season. Communities like Meaford and Thornbury have interesting shops and galleries and offer a variety of good restaurants. Hiking, biking, rock-climbing, and golf are all popular activities in the area. Bob Shearer points out; "The Fall is the season of fairs and arts and crafts shows. There is always something going on." Even spring can be fun as the land recovers from winter and a good hike can clear away those cobwebs. This truly is an all season location.
